





# CABIN FEVER CHALLENGE BIKE SWAP

Saturday, April 17, 2010, 1 pm – 230 pm


All items will be displayed in Wamego Middle School, Commons Area (except bicycles). Bicycles will need to be displayed outside at the entrance to the school.


